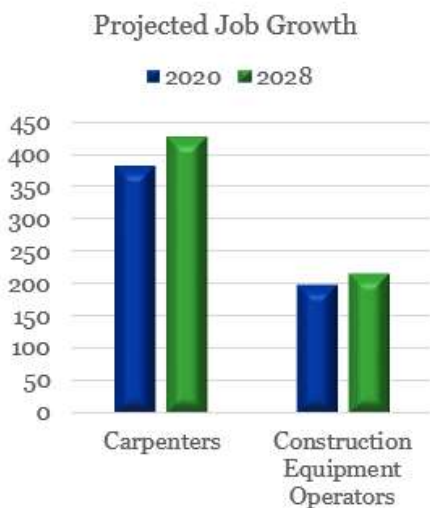


If you like to see the results of your work and want a job that pays well and gives you career paths to move up, construction may be for you.

In the last five years, construction employment in our region grew more than four times faster than employment in other sectors, and construction is expected to continue to grow in the next ten years.

Carpenters are key to the success of a construction project. They cut, shape, fit, and assemble building materials to construct buildings, bridges, and docks. Median earnings: \$42,200

Construction equipment operators use cranes, bulldozers, scrapers, forklifts, paving machines, and hoists. They also set up and inspect the equipment. Median earnings: \$50,100
