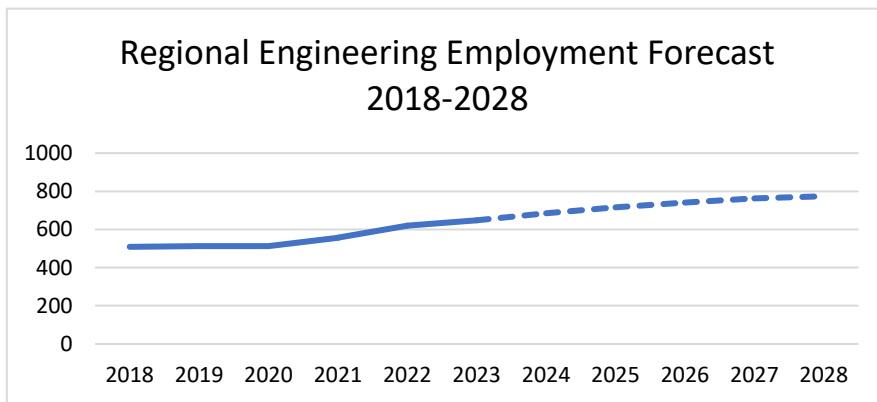


# Engineering - North Central ID & Southeast WA
