# Business & Industry Report



CEDA's loan capital has grown to \$5 million, a significant rise from \$3.5 million in 2019. With the addition of Idaho RLF capital, the total will reach \$8.3 million. Presently, CEDA has \$4.6 million ready for new projects and aims to grow its portfolio from \$3.5 million to \$5 million over the next 24 months.

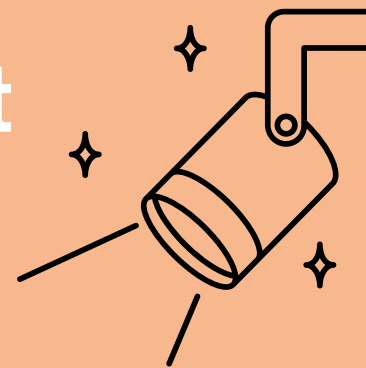


Stay in the Loop

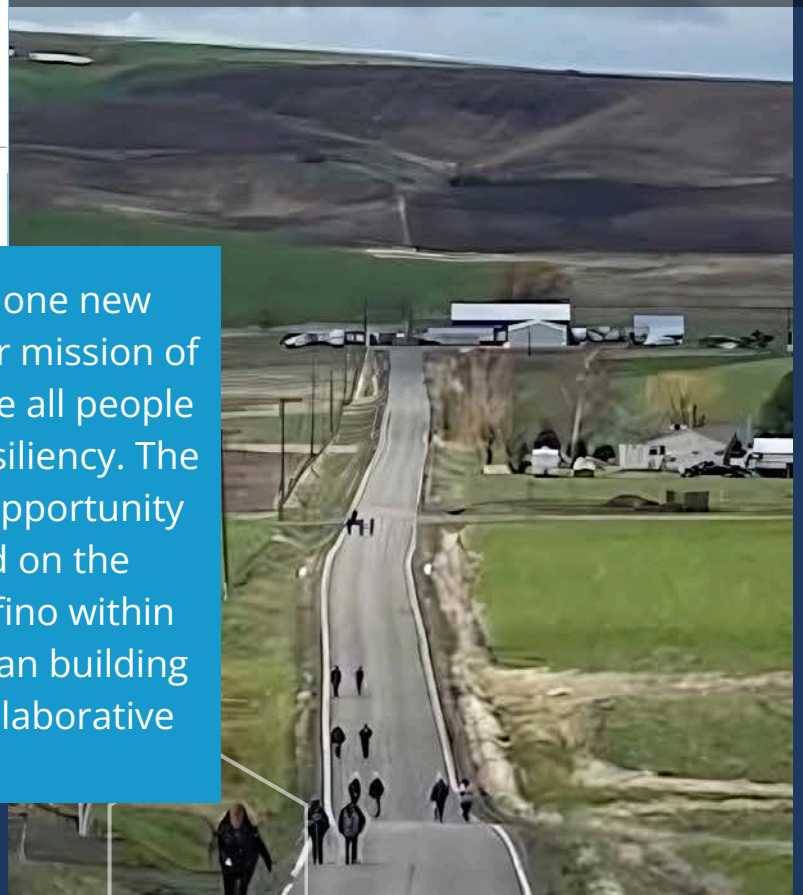
**Get Healthy**

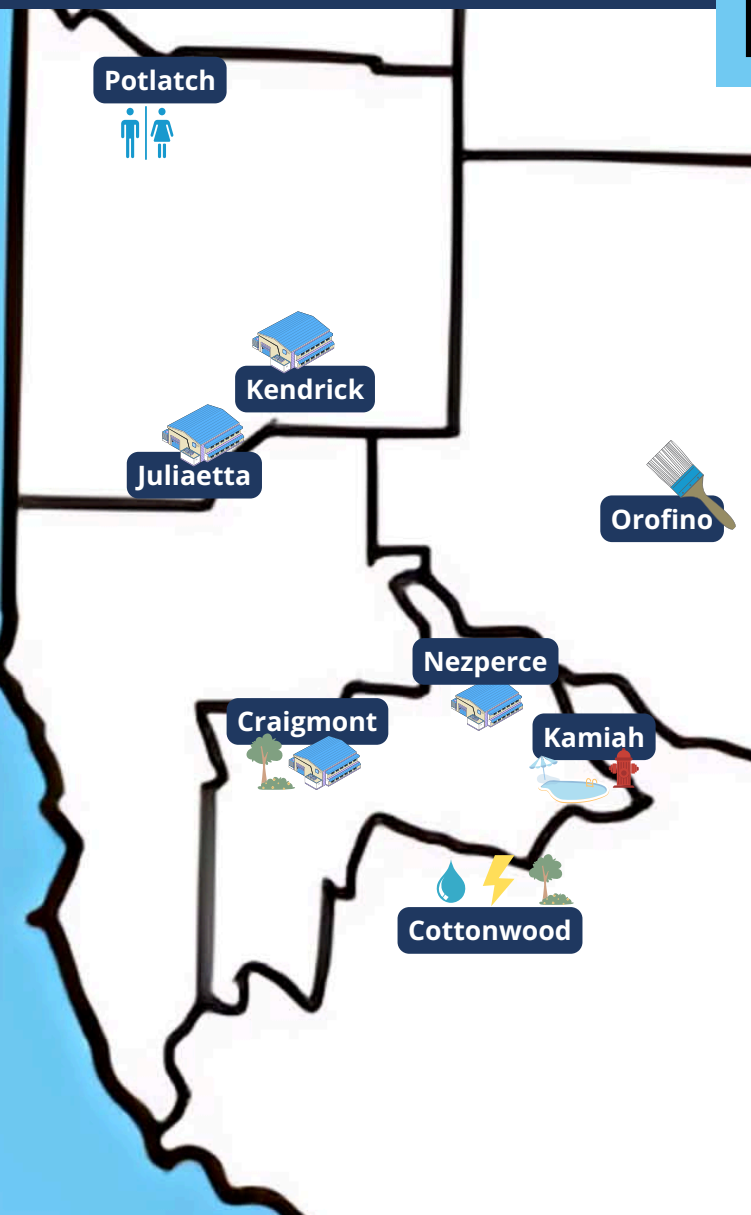

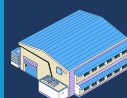

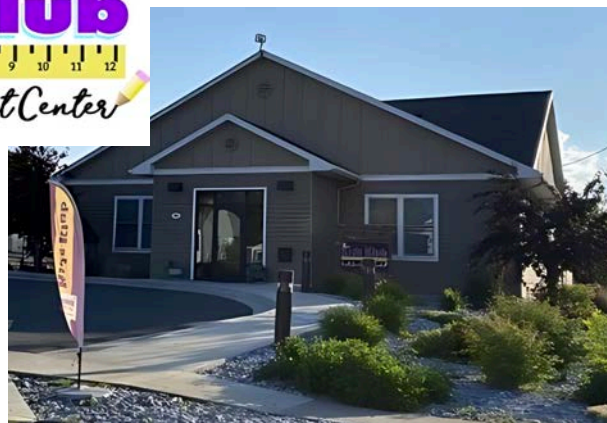
CEDA received an award from the Idaho Association for the Education of Young Children in December of 2023.

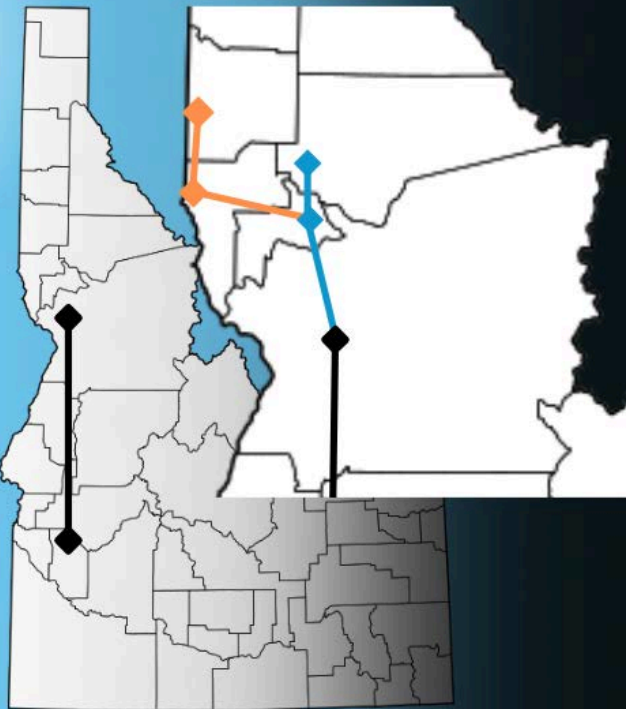

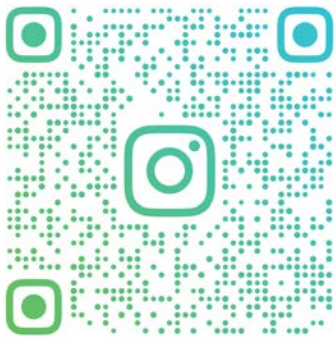

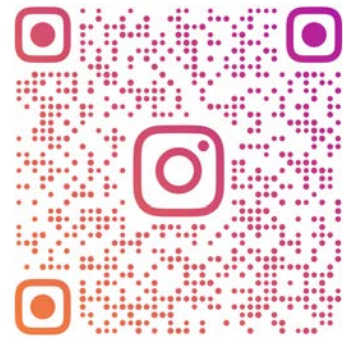
